### Introduction

This document outlines the latest updates to the CTIS system, including the secure Sponsor and Authority workspaces, and to the Clinical Trials website. Updates may include improvements to existing features and functionality, the addition of new features and functionality and technical improvements, such as improvements to system performance.

In this release, improvements have been made for:

- Application creation/preparation of documents and data
- Authorisation and supervision of clinical trials
- Other issues

#### **Functional Improvements**

- A. Improvements on the Application Creation/Preparation of documents and data
  - Fixed issue with partial submitted initial application in multination clinical trials, as a sponsor user I will be able to submit the part II for the MSC for which partial submission was done, even if the "estimated start of recruitment" date has passed, without throwing an error. [SD-723225]
  - Fixed issue with EudraCT search for transition trials, the sponsor user will be able to find and select a clinical trial available in EudraCT when searching with its EudraCT number in the Form section f . [SD-720582]

#### **B.** Authorisation and supervision of clinical trials

• Fixed issue with halted trials, if the authorised trial is not started/restarted within 2 years and 15 days the status now changes correctly to expired. [CTCS-21642]

#### C. Other issues

• Fixed issue with GPDR functionality, when trying to search for some document types to replace a document, the application now allows to search, and no error is displayed when pressing the 'Search' button. [SD-723186]
